2021 AGM Minutes

Committee Report delivered by Daniel Hill-Brown

The past 12 months has been a time of quite diverse changes at Flinders ES... We have seen significant change to our AFES partner staff team, shrinking from 6 to 3 at the start of 2022. This year has also seen Flinders ES bring back its start of year camp, Connect Camp, which was a fantastic time of fellowship to start 2022. Although certain aspects of Flinders ES have looked a little different this year, in contrast to previous years, one thing has remained the same, and that is that we are a club that exists to Know Jesus better, to love and serve him with our whole lives and actively seek out ways to share the gospel with our friends on campus...

Committee this year was made up of myself as President, Aidan Rice as Vice-President, Isabel Nietschke as Honorary Treasurer, Sarah Goldney as Honorary Secretary and Alyssa Calvert as a General Member...

Something that Committee was really keen to see growth in this year was ES being more present at Flinders Sturt and Tonsley Campuses, and we are so thankful to God to see growth in this area, with Small Groups and Jesus week events being held at Sturt and Tonsley this year...



We have also seen change this year in how we approach International Student ministry on campus...

Over the course of this year, there has been a real culture of student-led teams organising ES events in a staff-student partnership model, which is a little different to how we have consistently operated in the past...

Income and expense highlights:

GROW came in over budget. We were unable to get this down to only a loss of only \$371.22. Camps were able to break even with the use of subsidies.

Merchandising did not break even.

We did not use the funds budgeting for men's and women's events. This will be looked into for the coming year.

There were no fundraising events in the 2021-2022 financial year.

We had \$1083 donated, mainly from our graduates.

A detailed financial report will be sent to members in the coming weeks.

Membership Protection Policy

In response to FUSA regulations changes at the start of this year, FUSA encouraged all clubs to adopt a member protection policy to govern the code of conduct for members and what to do in the event of any misconduct. In response, Flinders ES drafted a Membership Protection Policy, with Daniel Hill-Brown and Michael Waskiel responsible for creating it. FUSA also requested that Clubs bring the Member Protection Policy to be voted in their By-



Laws. Our Member Protection Policy was sent out to Members in advance of this meeting. We now ask that Flinders ES adopts this policy.

Abbey Groocock moves that the Flinders ES adopt the Flinders Evangelical Students Member Protection Policy into its By-laws to accompany the provisions already contained in the Constitution of the Flinders ES and from this point for it to bind the conduct of all members. Alyssa Calvert seconds. Motion passed.

Election of the 2022/2023 Committee

In accordance with section 7.3 of the Constitution of the Flinders ES, Daniel Hill-Brown nominates Michael Waskiel to collect and/or count the votes. There were no objections. Daniel Hill-Brown declares all committee positions vacant, and stepped down as Chairperson.

Michael Waskiel declares the 2022/2023 committee to be elected.

In accordance with section 6.2. of the Constitution of the Flinders ES that states:

- 6.2 There shall be five (5) signatories to any account, of whom: i) at least three (3) are members of the Committee, and
 - ii) at most one (1) is a Senior AFES Flinders Staffworker, only when the Committee comprises of less than five (5) Enrolled Student/s, and
 - iii) at most two (2) are AFES Flinders Staffworkers, only when the Committee comprises of less than four (4) Enrolled Student/s.

Therefore, Owen Taylor will be added as a signatory to all ES bank accounts and made an Authoriser for all Internet Banking; and Sarah Goldney will be removed as a signatory and
